This Term's Focus: Building Independence

Throughout this term, our SEN team is focusing on developing independence skills across school life. This includes:

- Encouraging children to make simple choices
- Supporting organisation tools like visual timetables
- Developing self-help routines
- Promoting confidence during learning tasks

If you'd like ideas for supporting independence at home, please let us know—we're happy to help.

SEN Interventions and Support Updates

Our staff continue to deliver a range of tailored interventions, including:

- Speech and Language programmes
- Fine and gross motor skills groups
- Nurture and emotional wellbeing sessions
- Phonics and reading support groups
- Zones of Regulation activities

Your child's class teacher will be able to update you on any changes to their support plan.

Sensory Tips for Home

Many children benefit from sensory support throughout their day. Here are some easy activities you can try at home:

- Playdough, slime, or putty for fidgeting
- A quiet corner with cushions and low lighting
- Movement breaks such as wall pushes or star jumps
- Visual timers to support transitions
