Congratulations also to some of our children in Year 4 who celebrated their First Confession yesterday. It was a beautiful service and a very special occasion for all involved.

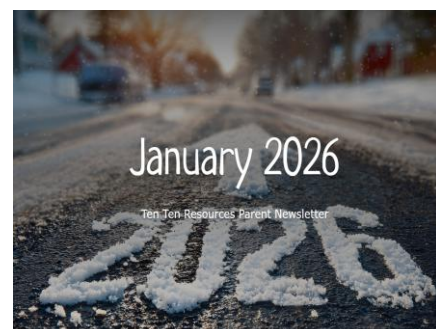
