Spring I

English

In English, we will be using the picture book 'Journey' by Aaron Becker as a stimulus for our writing. After sentence stacking lessons where children will be learning sentences techniques as well as developing vocabulary children will independently continue the plot of the narrative. The second English unit will be poetry focused. Children will be studying the poem 'The River' and writing their own rhyming stanzas and produce a weather poem.

Maths

In Maths, we will be continuing on multiplication practice every day for fluency in times tables. We will be looking at relationships, coordinates, fractions greater than 1 and decimals.

Science

In Science, the children will be learning about sound. During this unit of work, children will learn how vibrations cause sounds and how sounds travel through different mediums at different speeds.



The children will also be looking at living things and their habitats.

RE

In RE, the children will focus on two topics first being community and how the parish family play an important role in our local community and furthermore a longer topic which is about the Eucharist which supports the Holy Communion preparation.

History

Pupils will learn about who the Ancient Greeks were and the new ideas and inventions they brought to civilisation at the time. They will understand aspects of Ancient Greek life including their beliefs. They will understand the significance of certain individuals and their impact. Pupils will discover that the Ancient Greeks were responsible for many important cultural/social aspects and events that are still significant in present time (Olympic games, democracy etc.)



DT.

In Design Technology, children will generate, develop, model and communicate their ideas through discussion, annotated sketches, cross-sectional and exploded diagrams, prototypes, pattern pieces and computer aided design to make book cover with a fastening.

Computing

The children will be investigating weather and will use computers and different software to collect and present the data found.

PSHE

Created to Love Others explores the individual's relationship with others. Building on the understanding that we have been created out of love and for love, this module explores how we take this calling into our family, friendships and relationships, and teaches strategies for developing healthy relationships and keeping safe both online and in our daily lives.

PE

The Children will be developing their cricket skills and have PE with NUFC.
